The Idaho Board of Pharmacy dismissed an administrative complaint filed against Cindy A. Chambers and notified her that she was entitled to attorney fees. Over six months later, Chambers filed a declaration regarding her attorney fees. The Board found that that there was not good cause for Chambers' untimely filing and denied her requested attorney fees. Chambers filed a petition for judicial review with the district court, contending that the Board applied an erroneous legal standard, lacked substantial evidence for its findings, acted arbitrarily and capriciously, violated her due process rights, and prejudiced her substantial rights. The district court dismissed her petition. Chambers appeals.
