A jury found Alejandra Maria Ochoa guilty of misdemeanor vehicular manslaughter. On intermediate appeal, the district court vacated Ochoa's judgment of conviction and remanded the case for a new trial, concluding that evidence of the victim's blood toxicology was erroneously excluded, that Ochoa's request for a continuance was improperly denied, and that the State's pathologist should have been precluded from testifying about the contents of the victim's medical records. The State appeals.
