The Court, having received a recommendation to amend the Idaho Court Administrative Rules, and being fully informed as to the recommendation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Idaho Court Administrative Rules are amended as follows:

That Rule 32 be, and the same are hereby, AMENDED as follows:

Rule 32. Records of the judicial department--Examination and copying--Exemption from and limitations on disclosure

(g) Court records exempt from disclosure. Except as provided in paragraph (h) of this rule, court records specified below are exempt from disclosure. Any willful or intentional disclosure or accessing of a sealed or exempt court record, not otherwise authorized under this rule, may be treated as a contempt of court.

(29) Pending grant applications and attachments submitted to the Guardian Ad Litem Grant Review Board for consideration of grant funding authorized under Title 16, Chapter 16, Idaho Code. Provided, however, such applications and attachments will no longer be exempt following the Board's consideration of all applications and the Supreme Court's awarding of grant funds.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the amendment of Rule 32 shall be effective April 1, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that notice of this Order shall be published for three consecutive weeks on the Idaho State Bar's website and in its weekly E-Bulletin, and that as soon as practicable, a summary of the amendment(s) effected by this Order shall be published in one issue of The Advocate.
