ORDER

The Court having reviewed Idaho Appellate Rule 13, and the Court being fully informed;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Idaho Appellate Rules as they appear in the volume published by the Idaho Code Commission be, and they are hereby, amended as follows:

1. That Rule 13 be, and the same is hereby, amended as follows:

Idaho Appellate Rule 13. Stay of proceedings upon appeal or certification.

(c) **Stay Upon Appeal – Powers of District Court – Criminal Action.** In criminal actions, unless prohibited by order of the Supreme Court, the district court shall have the power and authority to rule upon the following motions and to take the following actions during the pendency of an appeal:

(8) Determine whether the defendant should be allowed bail, and if the defendant is allowed bail:

- (i) Determine the amount of bail;
- (ii) Modify the amount of bail from time to time;
- (iii) Forfeit bail for violation of any of its conditions;
- (iv) Issue a bench warrant for the arrest of the defendant for violation of

bail.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this order and these amendments shall be effective the 1st day of July, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the above designation of the striking of words from the Rules by lining through them, and the designation of the addition of new portions of the Rules by underlining such new portion is for the purposes of information only as amended, and NO OTHER AMENDMENTS ARE INTENDED. The lining through and underlining shall not be considered a part of the permanent Idaho Appellate Rules.
