NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Rule 14 of the Idaho Misdemeanor Criminal Rules be amended as follows:

Idaho Misdemeanor Criminal Rule 14. Disposition of Citations by Written Plea of Guilty - Limitations - Deferred Payment Agreements.

- (b) Limitation on offenses for written plea of guilty. A written plea of guilty can be accepted under subsection (a) of this rule only if the required bail bond under Rule 13 does not exceed:
 - (1) \$276.00 for a motor vehicle offense.
 - (2) \$582.00 for offenses under I.C. Sections 49-432, 49-432(2)(a), 49-432(2)(b), 63-2450 and 63-2455.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this order and these amendments shall be effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the above designation of the striking of words from the Rules by lining through them, and the designation of the addition of new portions of the Rules by underlining such new portion is for the purposes of information only as amended, and NO OTHER AMENDMENTS ARE INTENDED. The lining through and underlining shall not be considered a part of the permanent Idaho Criminal Rules.
