This Court has, effective January 1, 2024, amended Idaho Court Administrative Rule 32 to provide for the shielding of court records from public disclosure pursuant to I.C. § 67-3004(11). This rule amendment specifically permits law enforcement personnel and prosecuting attorneys acting within the exercise of their official duties and powers to access court records that are shielded from public disclosure; and,

This Court's April 11, 2016, Order "In re: Extended Access" grants law enforcement personnel and prosecuting attorneys extended access to the Idaho Supreme Court Data Repository and iCourt Portal under certain conditions.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that persons with extended law enforcement access ("LEA ACCESS") or prosecutor access ("PROS ACCESS") pursuant to the April 11, 2016, Order "In re: Extended Access" may utilize such extended access within the exercise of their official duties and powers to identify and obtain information about cases with court records that have been shielded from public disclosure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the access granted by this Order is specifically conditioned upon the terms of the Extended Access User Agreement signed by the user utilizing such access.
