Special Committee on Judicial Recruitment and Selection

Blue-Ribbon Committee on Judicial Recruitment

The Idaho Supreme Court will appoint a blue-ribbon committee to examine ways to improve judicial recruitment in Idaho.

Recruiting highly qualified judges is essential to the Supreme Court's constitutional mission to provide timely, fair and impartial justice. However, encouraging the best and brightest to apply has become an increasing challenge — particularly for district judge vacancies.

This special committee is in keeping with an Idaho tradition of using thoughtful and deliberative processes to address changes to judicial recruitment and selection processes. The committee is expected to work within the 2022 calendar year, providing recommendations to shape later reforms.

The Supreme Court earlier this year surveyed members of the Idaho State Bar about their views on judicial service and recruitment in this state. The Supreme Court will work with its blue-ribbon committee to review the results of that survey (published below) and address questions that arise from it.
