

I.C.A.R. 54. Guardianships and Conservatorships

Idaho Court Administrative Rule 54. Guardianships and Conservatorships.

Every individual seeking appointment as a guardian or conservator shall file with the court a certificate of completion of the Supreme Court's online training course relating to the duties and responsibilities of a guardian or conservator prior to the issuance of permanent letters of guardianship or conservatorship, unless otherwise waived by the court for good cause. The Supreme Court may charge a \$25.00 fee to participants to cover the cost of furnishing this training. This fee shall be deposited in the guardianship pilot project fund as provided in section 31-3201 G, Idaho Code. This rule shall not apply to cases involving the guardianship or conservatorship of a minor.
