



IRFLP 110 Substitution of Attorney

Idaho Rules of Family Law Procedure Rule 110. Substitution of Attorney.

(a) **In General.** An attorney may be substituted by filing written notice with the court. The notice must be signed by both the new attorney and the withdrawing attorney. This rule only applies when a licensed attorney seeks to replace a licensed attorney.

(b) **Effect of Substitution.** The substitution of attorneys or the appearance of a new attorney must not delay the proceedings except for good cause.
