<b>Total Participants- All Funding Sources:</b>	Sum of all active participants as of the last day of the month from all funding sources
<b>DHW Funded Slots</b>	Number of DHW funded slots currently allotted to the specific court
<b>DHW Participants</b>	Number of active participants associated with DHW Funded Slots as of the last day of the month
<b>DHW Slots Remaining</b>	DHW Funded Slots minus DHW Participants as of last day of the month
<b>DHW % Utilization</b>	Number of DHW Participants divided by DHW Funded Slots
