WHEREAS, the Idaho Supreme Court has adopted the Idaho Rules of Family Law Procedure effective July 1, 2015, and


WHEREAS, the Idaho Supreme Court has further ordered that any judicial district may implement these rules at an earlier date by Administrative Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Idaho Rules of Family Law Procedure as published in the Idaho Rules Volumes shall apply to all family law cases filed in the Magistrate's Division of the Fifth Judicial District on or after July 1, 2014, as set out below.

These rules shall govern the procedure in the magistrate's division of the district court in all actions for divorce, child support, child custody, paternity, all proceedings pursuant to the Domestic Violence Crime Prevention Act, all actions pursuant to the De Facto Custodian Act, and all proceedings, judgments or decrees related to the modification or enforcement of such orders in such actions, except contempt. These rules shall not apply to actions arising under the Child Protection Act, actions for adoption, actions for termination of parental rights, or actions for guardianships or conservatorships.
