Advisory: Jan. 14 Oral Argument in *Durst, et al., v. Idaho Commission for Reapportionment*

At 1:30 p.m. Friday, Jan. 14, the Idaho Supreme Court will hear oral argument in four consolidated cases challenging Idaho's legislative redistricting plan. The hearing will be held at the Supreme Court courtroom in Boise and per the [Court's scheduling order](#), is expected to last two hours.

The Jan. 14 hearing will be streamed online through [Idaho In Session](#), available to anyone with an internet-connected phone or computer.

For those still wishing to attend in person, current COVID-19 precautions in the Supreme Court building will limit seating in the courtroom. Overflow seating will be available in the Lincoln Room in the basement of the Supreme Court building.
