## Seating and Cameras for Sept. 29 Oral Argument

The Idaho Supreme Court on Sept. 29 will hear oral argument on the merits of the three consolidated Planned Parenthood Great Northwest v. State of Idaho cases.

As with an earlier hearing in these cases, anyone who wishes to attend in person must reserve their seating through free tickets, the Supreme Court announced today.

Tickets for the two-hour, 9 a.m. hearing are necessary due to expected high demand for courtroom seating. Tickets are limited to two per request and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

To request a ticket, please email <u>supremecourtdocuments@idcourts.net</u> with the names and phone numbers of each person you would like to attend. Outside of emergencies, any changes to confirmed tickets must be requested by Sept. 28, the day before the hearing.

Attendees are advised to review both the <u>security rules</u> in place at the Supreme Court building and the <u>courtroom decorum order</u> issued in these cases.

The oral argument will be streamed live for anyone to watch online through <u>Idaho In</u> <u>Session</u>. Per the Supreme Court's <u>order</u>, no other broadcast cameras will be allowed in the courtroom but requests can be submitted for still photography.

Only one still photographer will be allowed in the courtroom, acting as a pool photographer. Pooling arrangements, including who the photographer will be, must be handled by the requesting organizations. A photo request can be emailed as a Word or PDF file at least one business day in advance of the hearing to <u>supremecourtdocuments@idcourts.net</u>. The request form can be <u>found here</u>.
