Justice Cynthia Meyer to Take Public Oath of Office on Jan. 5

Justice Cynthia Meyer will publicly take her oath of office in a ceremony at 10 a.m. Friday, Jan. 5, at the Idaho Supreme Court courtroom in Boise.

The public, friends and family are invited to attend the formal investiture ceremony and a reception immediately following. The ceremony will also be streamed live online through [Idaho In Session](#).

Justice Meyer was privately sworn in earlier this week to allow her to begin the duties of an Idaho Supreme Court justice, as is common practice. The Jan. 5 ceremony provides formal public recognition of her assuming that office.

Gov. Brad Little on Nov. 6 appointed Justice Meyer to fill the remaining term of Justice John Stegner, who retired Oct. 31. Prior to her appointment, Justice Meyer was a district judge in the First Judicial District, most recently serving as that district's administrative judge.
