Learn About Idaho's Courts: 2025 Annual Report Now Available

The Idaho Supreme Court has released its annual update on projects, programs and priorities of the Judicial Branch – a resource for anyone looking to learn more about Idaho's state courts.

The Court's annual report, published at <u>annualreport.isc.idaho.gov</u>, provides information on how Idaho's courts operate and on programs such as treatment courts and family court services. The website also describes the Court's 2025 requests to the Idaho Legislature, which this year include significant changes to judicial compensation and separately, funding for new judges in three counties.

The website also provides links to extensive data about the state courts. This includes a broad view of finances for local trial courts and a link to <u>courtdata.idaho.gov</u>, a site with statistics about cases filed in Idaho courts and fines and fees processed through the courts.

The website will include a recording of Chief Justice G. Richard Bevan's yearly address to the Legislature after that speech takes place later this month.
