New Trial Court Administrator Named for Idaho's First Judicial District

Lisa Chesebro, a longtime attorney with experience across north Idaho, will become the next trial court administrator for the First Judicial District starting Friday, Jan. 24.

A trial court administrator keeps local courts running smoothly. They help manage court operations and implement court programs across each of Idaho's seven judicial districts. The First Judicial District includes Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, Kootenai and Shoshone counties.

Chesebro received her law degree in 2007 from the University of Idaho School of Law. In the years since, she has worked across the First District as a public defender, prosecutor, and as a private attorney addressing probate and wills, evictions, property disputes and other matters. She has practiced law in four of the five counties that make up her district.

A resident of Shoshone County, Chesebro said she now wants to help improve the court experience in the Panhandle.
