South-Central Idaho Courts Receive New Trial Court Administrator

A south-central Idaho native will help lead court operations across Idaho's Fifth Judicial District.

Sadie Fisher will become the district's trial court administrator effective July 1. She succeeds retiring Trial Court Administrator Shelli Tubbs.

A trial court administrator keeps local courts running smoothly. They help manage court operations and implement court programs across each of Idaho's seven judicial districts. The Fifth Judicial District includes Blaine, Camas, Cassia, Gooding, Jerome, Lincoln, Minidoka and Twin Falls counties.

Fisher is a graduate of Idaho State University and the University of Idaho. She began her career working for the Armed Services YMCA, a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving active-duty military service members and their families. After moving back to Idaho, she worked in multiple roles based in Twin Falls County for the state court system. Since 2022, she has served as deputy trial court administrator for the Fifth District, assisting Tubbs in managing local court operations.
