The Idaho File and Serve system supports mandatory and voluntary electronic filing throughout Idaho's court system. On the evening of Friday, September 12, 2025, and potentially Saturday, September 13, 2025, the File and Serve system will be periodically unavailable to users. Idaho Rules for Electronic Filing and Service (I.R.E.F.S.) 12 states that any document filed before midnight is deemed filed that day. I.R.E.F.S. 14 provides for relief if the electronic filing system is temporarily unavailable.

Because File and Serve will be temporarily unavailable on Friday, September 12, 2025, and potentially Saturday, September 13, 2025, any document that was due to be electronically filed on either of those days will be deemed timely if filed on or before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 15, 2025. The requirement in I.R.E.F.S. 14 of individualized requests for relief shall be waived.
