IN RE: EXTENDED TIME TO FILE DUE TO ELECTRONIC FILING SYSTEM OUTAGE April 18-19, 2025 Electronic Filing Outage Order

The Idaho File and Serve system supports mandatory and voluntary electronic filing throughout Idaho's court system. On the evening of Friday, April 18, 2025, and potentially Saturday, April 19, 2025, the File and Serve system will be periodically unavailable to users. Idaho Rule for Electronic Filing and Service (I.R.E.F.S.) 12 states that any document filed before midnight is deemed filed that day. I.R.E.F.S. 14 provides for relief if the electronic filing system is temporarily unavailable.

Because File and Serve will be temporarily unavailable on Friday, April 18, 2025, and potentially Saturday, April 19, 2025, any document that was due to be electronically filed on either of those days will be deemed timely if filed on or before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 21, 2025. The requirement in I.R.E.F.S. 14 of individualized requests for relief shall be waived.
