Ideas for Virtual Volunteering & Remote CSW

-Write and mail handwritten notes to nursing homes, health care workers, or first responders letting them know you appreciate their work and are thinking of them

-Artwork, written work, or a dance that expresses what you are grateful for

-Make a Tik Tok video of gratitude and post it

-Write positive messages in chalk on the sidewalk for others to read

-Paint rocks with positive messages and scatter on trails for others to read

-Place **stuffed animals** in your window, encourage others to do the same, and take your kids for a walk to spot them in your neighbor's windows

-Pick up and bag trash/garbage in your neighborhood
