

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Goggin, Docket No. 40554

Charlynda Goggin was convicted by an Ada County jury of delivery of a controlled substance (a synthetic cannabinoid commonly called “spice”), delivery of drug paraphernalia, and conspiracy to deliver both. After the jury returned its guilty verdict on the four charges, Goggin filed a motion to acquit and a motion for a new trial. The district judge denied the motion to acquit but granted the motion for a new trial on the conspiracy charges. The Supreme Court upheld the denial of the motion to acquit but reversed the grant of a new trial on the conspiracy charges.
