

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Tollman, Docket No. 44648

In a case arising out of Ada County, the Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court's order, which denied Teresa Lee Tollman's ("Tollman") request for restricted driving privileges. Tollman argued that the district court erred when it failed to apply a 2015 amendment to Idaho Code section 18-8005(6)(d) (the "Amendment"), which permitted her to apply for a restricted driver's license. Specifically, Tollman argued that the Amendment should have been applied because she filed her request for a restricted driver's license after the Amendment was enacted.

In a unanimous decision, the Idaho Supreme Court held that the district court properly denied Tollman's request for restricted driving privileges because Tollman's sentence was final at the time the Amendment was enacted, and there is no legislative intent that the Amendment apply retroactively.
