

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Wilson

The Supreme Court affirmed the Canyon County district court's judgment of conviction convicting Richard Wilson of two counts of aiding and abetting trafficking methamphetamine. The Supreme Court held that the evidence presented at trial was sufficient to support Wilson's convictions. More specifically, the Court held that Idaho Code Section 37-2732B(a)(4) did not require the State to prove that Wilson had advance knowledge of the quantity of methamphetamine being sold, that the State presented sufficient evidence of a representation by the seller that met the requirements of Idaho Code Section 37-2732B(c), and that Wilson knew the seller was trafficking methamphetamine.
