

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Albertson

Docket No. 45607

The Supreme Court affirmed the Minidoka County district court's order denying Albertson's motion to suppress evidence obtained after an officer approached Albertson's home to speak with him. The Court held that the single no trespassing sign that Albertson posted on a corner of his property was insufficient to revoke the implied license for the public, including police officers, to approach his home. Therefore, it held that the officer's conduct did not constitute a search for purposes of either the U.S. constitution or the Idaho constitution.
