

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Saldivar

Docket No. 46098

The Supreme Court reversed an Ada County district court decision granting Isaac Saldivar's motion to suppress evidence obtained during a pat search of his person for weapons. The Court held that the pat search was reasonable under the totality of the circumstances, and as a result, it was unnecessary to address whether Saldivar's status as a parolee, who waived his rights concerning searches, precluded him from having a reasonable expectation of privacy or whether the inevitable discovery exception applied. In light of its decision, the Court remanded the case for further proceedings.
