

## **SUMMARY STATEMENT**

*State v. Gonzalez*

The Supreme Court affirmed the decision of the district court in denying Gonzalez's motion for credit for time served. Zuatney Gonzalez was arrested and jailed in Canyon County. While there, she was served with a Bannock County arrest warrant for charges unrelated to her Canyon County incarceration. Later, she was again served with the same arrest warrant. After pleading guilty to the Bannock County charges, she requested credit for time served from the date of the issuance of the Bannock County arrest warrant. The district court granted credit for time served from the second service of the Bannock County arrest warrant to the date of her sentencing, and denied the rest of Gonzalez's motion. She appealed the partial denial of her motion for credit for time served, but her argument was different in the briefing and changed again during oral arguments. The Supreme Court held that the issue she raised on appeal and the issue raised during oral arguments was not properly raised before the district court.
